## Being Sopher

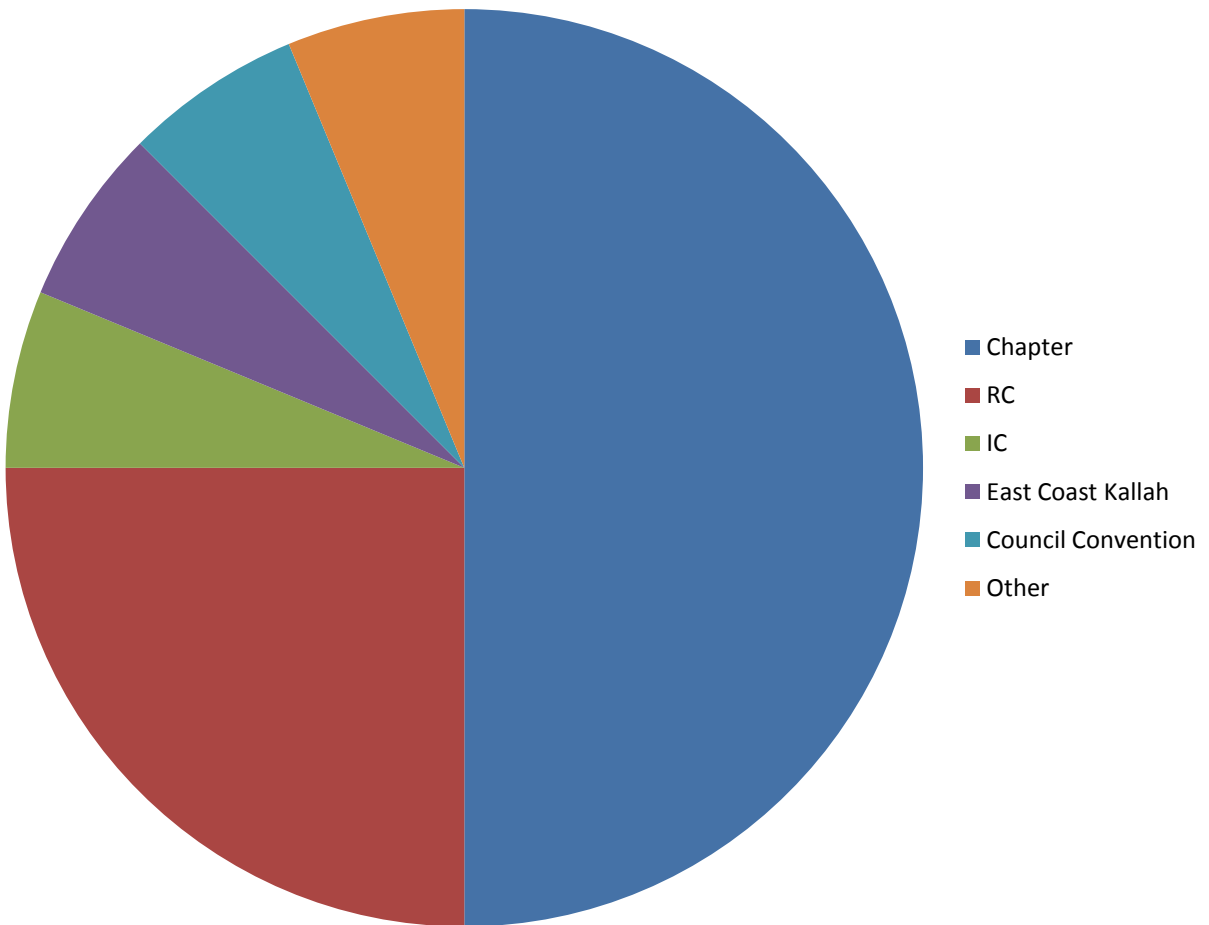

## Review of Kinect for the xbox 360

In case you don't know kinect is a fully motion sensing add-n to the xbox 360. No controllers required. This also means if you choose to buy one you won't be spending your hard earned Chanukah money on \$50 controllers. In fighting games, for example, instead of pressing "A" to punch you will physically throw a punch at your enemy. The kinect sees your motions with 3D mapping technology and therefore is extremely accurate in transforming your physical movements into the game. on some things there is a slightly noticeable delay from the kinect but this is rare and does not effect gameplay. Unfortunately, as of this moment all games excluding "Fighters Unleashed" and "Dance Central" are preview games. Games such as "Kinect Adventures", which comes free with the kinect, and "kinectimals" only show you what the kinect is capable of and will provide the same entertainment as Wii Sports, with a kinect twist, with no real satisfaction for hardcore gamers. That is not longterm satisfaction most gamers are looking for. Multiplayer has finally been perfected. Your friends can jump in and out of games at any time without affecting your current game. I highly suggest buying kinect sometime in the future. Wait until more hardcore games come out for it. Kinect works extremely well and does what it is intended to do, create a controller free gaming experience with excellent mulitplayer. Taking into consideration the lack of hardcore games, at the moment kinect gets an 8.5 out of 10.
